Types of Planned Gifts

- ◆ Bequests Bequests are a common and easy way to make a long-lasting impact in support of MOCA Tucson programming. You can designate a percentage of your will or living trust to ensure the gift remains proportionate to the size of your estate, or you can give a certain amount of cash, securities, or property.
- ◆ Gifts of Life Insurance Life insurance is another type of asset that you can use to make a gift to the museum. Name MOCA Tucson as a beneficiary of your life insurance policy's death benefit.
- ◆ Gifts of Retirement Plans Retirement plan assets, such as your IRA, 401(k), pension, or other tax-deferred plan, can make a big impact as a planned gift. Retirement plan assets can be taxed, which can deplete a portion of your hard-earned savings. By naming MOCA Tucson as a beneficiary of all, or a portion of your retirement plan, the full value of your assets can make a positive impact in our community.

These and other options are available to help support MOCA Tucson beyond your lifetime. Establishing a planned gift is straightforward—you can change your mind at any time—and it can cost nothing to set up.
